

Treasurer's Summary for the year ending December 31, 2014

NCC had a very interesting year 2014.

NCC purchased the adjoining property with 2 commercial buildings which we hope to rent soon. Thanks to the efforts of Larry Everett, Cindy Arent, Lindy Thaxton, and the donations of materials and labor from many of our Members. On behalf of NCC, we extend a special thank you to Fleur De Lys Healy for her generous donation of \$12,000 to pay down the loan for the new property. The remaining balance now stands at \$113,000.

The Museum had a record year thanks to Cindy Arent, Lindy Thaxton, Betty Sivard, Sandra Rohrbough, Julie Davey & all the members that constantly volunteer at the Museum. Admissions were up \$2,000 over the previous year. The Museum Sales also increased to give the Museum a net increase \$9,000 over 2013. If not for the added expense of the new property, the Museum would have been self-supporting. Which is quite an event.

The Museum Forever Raffle which start June 2013 and concluded at the 2014 Convention raised in total \$13,000 for the Endowment fund, \$5,000 in 2013 and an additional \$8,000 in 2014. I thank everyone who generously supported the Museum Forever Raffle effort. With this addition the NCC MUSEUM endowment is up to \$310,000.

All in all 2014 was a very exciting year for NCC.
